



Summer Internship Application Process

- Complete the application online at drvision.org. (On the website look at the bottom right hand corner under GO. Click on "Internship" to find the application.)

While we have not established a deadline for Summer Internship Applications, we strongly recommend that you submit your application by March 1 to allow you sufficient time to raise needed support.

- Within 10 days of receiving their application, potential interns will be contacted by email to set up a phone or Skype interview. This will also provide a time for parents to ask questions regarding the program
- Within 10 days of the interview individuals will be notified of their acceptance as a Summer Intern. We will then send a planning packet so that you can begin raising support and make all the needed preparations for your summer internship.
- Within one week of their acceptance into the program the \$100 commitment fee must be paid to Daystar Baptist Missions. We have a limited number of interns that we can accept into the program so we must receive this fee as the individual's commitment to attend. Once the office receives your commitment deposit we will send you your preparation packet.
- Send out your support letters. A proven way of raising your support is to send out 75-100 letters. Most who do this raise all their funds needed for the trip. A sample letter will be provided in your packet.
- Follow the preparations guideline found in your "Internship Packet." This has all of the needed steps that you need to complete before coming to the DR.
- Make your final payment 30 days prior to your arrival in the DR. See the FAQs and the "Internship Packet" regarding extra money raised. You must have \$2,600 (which includes your commitment fee) in your DBMI account 30 days prior to your arrival.
