



## Summer Internship Financial Information

Commitment Fee	\$100	This is a deposit against the tuition which is required upon acceptance and holds the place for the student. This must be paid to the DBMI office in order to begin the process of raising your support. (Nonrefundable)
Tuition (Entire Summer)	\$2,500	Includes lodging, meals, classroom instruction books, accident insurance, several cultural trips and activities, in-country transportation, and planned trips. (See FAQs regarding tuition refunds and credits.) <b><i>Does not include air fares to and from the Dominican Republic, tourist visa (\$10) purchased at the airport upon entry, Exit Fees (\$60), souvenirs, personally planned excursions, or personal items.</i></b>
Budget Plan		<p>Prospective Interns must pay \$100 upon acceptance into the summer internship program. This must be sent to the DBMI office in order to set up your account and to guarantee your place on the field.</p> <p>An individual account will be set up at the office for you. Any money sent in for you will be deposited into your account. A receipt will automatically be sent to each donor. A statement will also be provided to you with the name and address of each donor, as well as the amount given. All checks sent in should be made out to Daystar Baptist Missions Inc. and designated for the intern.</p> <p><b>The balance of \$2,500 must be received NO LATER than 30 days prior to the trip.</b></p> <p>NOTE ALSO: THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS WHATSOEVER FOR STUDENTS WHO WITHDRAW FROM THE PROGRAM.
